

Accessibility Survey

Through the summer and fall Toronto Conference completed a first round of an accessibility survey to annotate the [Community of Faith Directory on our website](#) and indicate their accessibility features related to barrier free access, lgbtq+ affirming ministry and languages spoken in worship. Positive responses to the survey questions appear on the website listing of the congregation under the related heading.

Next Steps

We need to tweak some of the language to make it more accurate based on the experience of trying to complete the survey.

To date here are the results of congregations who have completed the survey:

- Living Waters 43/75 complete 57%
- Northern Waters 45/67 complete 67%
- Toronto Southeast 29/52 complete 55%
- South West 34/51 complete 66%

The next step is to send a message to all communities of faith and invite them to check their listing and to ask Presbytery administrative staff to follow up with their outstanding congregations as they are able. A further reflection on the process of creating and implementing the survey will be available shortly.
