May 27-28, 2016**

The 92nd annual meeting of Toronto Conference took place on May 27-28, 2016 at the North Simcoe Sports & Recreation Centre and St. Paul's United Church, Midland. The theme was "Weaving Our Stories into God's Love".

FRIDAY, May 27, 2016**MORNING SESSION**Gathering music

Gathering music was led by Paul Rumbolt.

Welcome, honouring the land and constituting the Court

President Bryan Ransom welcomed people to the 92nd annual meeting of the Conference. The court acknowledged the Indigenous peoples on whose land the meeting was being held. Jake Charles of Georgina Island sang a song of welcome and Councillor Joanne Sandy representing the Chief of Christian Island First Nations welcomed people to the territorial lands of Beausoleil First Nation. The President constituted the meeting in the name of Jesus Christ to conduct business properly brought before it.

Worship and theme

The President introduced a number of presenters and led the meeting in worship and community building, assisted by Karen Hilfman-Millson. The focus was on the theme and right relations between Indigenous and non-Indigenous people.

Quorum

The Executive Secretary explained that the meeting required 175 people to obtain quorum. A count was conducted which found that 171 voting members present. Without quorum, the "meeting" became a "gathering" using warm and cool cards to get a sense of the direction to be taken; this would provide advice to the Conference Executive which would vote on any business items. The gathering AGREED that quorum would be checked again in the afternoon.

MORNING SESSION

Gathering music

Service of Remembering

Chaplains Sungmin Jung and Ruth McDonald led a time of worship, including a remembrance of congregations which had closed or amalgamated, those who had died in the last year and the brokenness of relations between Indigenous and non-Indigenous people in Canada.

Workshops

The morning session continued with workshops. Everyone had opportunity to attend a different workshop than they had the day before.

Right Relations

Jennifer Henry and Lorna Pawis led the court in some reflective time regarding right relations between Indigenous and non-Indigenous people.

Announcements and grace

President-Elect Audrey Brown made a number of announcements, and Paul Rumbolt led grace.

AFTERNOON SESSION

Gathering music

Gathering music was led by Paul Rumbolt.

The President welcomed everyone back to the gathering.

Jubilands

The President asked jubilands to stand and the court offered a round of applause to thank them for their years of ministry.

Questions on accountability reports

Members of the court had an opportunity to submit questions about items in the various accountability reports. No questions were received.

Quorum

Before the business session began, the scrutineers counted to ensure that there was quorum. Quorum was not reached (171 voting members were present) but upon a recount when additional people were rounded up, quorum was achieved.

Proposal to Toronto Conference #1 – General Council grant

President-Elect Audrey Brown made a brief presentation on the proposal.

MOTION by Ross Leckie/Lawrence Nyarko that this 92nd annual meeting of Toronto Conference approve that the 2016 and 2017 General Council grants be reduced to \$0 and request the General Council to redirect those funds to assist other Conferences to remain viable.

Proposal to Toronto Conference #2 – 2017-2019 Conference budget and assessments

The Executive Secretary made brief remarks regarding the 2017 budget and the years that follow, and answered questions.

MOTION by Linda Parsons/Martha Wood that this 92nd annual meeting of Toronto Conference approve the 2017 budget and receive for information the projected budgets for 2018 and 2019.

Proposal to Toronto Conference #3 – Affirming Ministry

Cynthia O'Connell, a member of the Affirming Ministry Task Group, made a brief presentation on the proposal.

MOTION by Cynthia O'Connell/Martha Wood that this 92nd annual meeting of Toronto Conference authorize the Conference Executive to develop an affirming ministry vision statement and action plan to be presented at the 2017 annual meeting.

MOTION CARRIED.

Proposal to Toronto Conference #4 – World Religions

Ross Carson from York Pines United Church made a presentation on the proposal and answered questions for clarification.

MOTION by David Allen/Audrey Brown that Toronto Conference of The United Church of Canada recommend to the Government of the Province of Ontario that a course in World Religions be mandatory for students graduating with an Ontario Secondary School Diploma.

New Business #1 – rescinding sub-Executive motion

The Executive Secretary outlined the process to be followed when dealing with the next item of business. Members of the Conference’s Interview Committee left the court, thus causing quorum to be lost. The gathering continued to discuss the proposal.

Randy Bowes, chair of West Hill United Church, made a brief presentation on the proposal. Martha ter Kuile, chair of Toronto Southeast Presbytery, spoke about the presbytery’s response to the proposal. The Executive Secretary answered a number of questions for clarification

Members of the Conference Interview Committee returned to the court, thus re-gaining quorum.

The vote was 51 in favour, 100 opposed with three spoiled ballots.

President-Elect Audrey Brown thanked a number of people and offered a special thank you to President Bryan Ransom for his service over the last two years. She presented a gift to him. The court responded with applause.

Closing prayers

The President offered a word of thanks to everyone and the staff, Executive Secretary David Allen, the Conference Executive and offered prayer to close the afternoon session.

EVENING SESSIONCelebration of Ministries service

The 92nd annual meeting of Toronto Conference concluded with the Celebration of Ministries service at St. Paul's United Church, Midland. President Bryan Ransom presided, assisted by Executive Secretary David Allen, President-Elect Audrey Brown and Karen Hilfman-Millson. Jennifer Henry delivered the message. Six people were ordained – Debbie Boukydis-Grant, Alexander Constable, Meg Jordan, Linda Newnham, Lawrence Nyarko and Kathy Underwood. Amy Crawford and Tessica Hackshaw were admitted to the order of ministry of The United Church of Canada. Designated Lay Ministers, Doreen Mason and Barry Rieder, who had been recognized by their presbyteries, participated in the service. Barbara Creelman, DLM could not be present.

He studied theology at Emmanuel College, University of Toronto, where he met many of his lifetime friends and remained involved with various events at the college throughout his life. He was an active United Church minister for 60 years, serving charges in Sudbury, Windsor, London and various churches in the GTA. He was the minister at Knox United Church, Agincourt, for 20 of those years and welcomed many new members into the Christian family.

He was interested in a lifetime of learning and took university courses well into his 80s. He loved to spend time with his family and friends, read, listen to CBC radio and travel. He could be seen out for his daily morning walk, waving to the neighbours as he went past. He was a former member of the Agincourt Rotary Club and curled with his fellow ministers for a number of years.

He led a blessed life and will be really missed by his son and daughter, by his friends and by the congregations he served.

Rev. John Morris (January 9, 1920 - April 11, 2016)

It is with sadness that we learned of the death of Rev. John Morris, on Monday, April 11, 2016 in Credit Valley Hospital. He was predeceased by his wife Kay (nee Smith, deceased 1983) and his brother Bill. John is survived by his brother the Rev. Paul Morris, son Lee (Yuri), daughter Marilyn Gough (Barry), grandsons Spencer Gough (Jessica Nowlan) and Zachary Gough.

John had a long career in the United Church, mostly in southern Ontario. Following some earlier assignments in Saskatchewan and Alberta, John was minister to the Stroud-Lefroy charge 1949-1954; Aurora 1954-1961; Associate Minister at Timothy Eaton Memorial (Toronto) 1961-1964; St. Andrew's (Oshawa) 1964- 1975; Binkley (Hamilton) 1975-1985; and Associate Minister at St. Paul's (Brampton) 1985-2001.

Rev. Benjamin Murata (June 7, 1927 – January 27, 2016)

Rev. Benjamin Toyot-tsune Murata passed away suddenly yet peacefully at the Toronto Western Hospital on Wednesday, January 27, 2016, in his 88th year. He was the beloved husband of Esther Takeko Murata, with whom he would have celebrated their 60th anniversary in April 2016. He was father to David Nobu-tsune, Mary Madoka, E.H. Erika, and Paul Hiro-tsune and grandfather to Lucian, William and Saya.

Benjamin was born in Kagoshima, Japan, graduated from the 7th National Collegiate Institute and the University of Tokyo, and, as a Fulbright Scholar, he graduated from the Emmanuel College, University of Toronto. As an ordained minister with The United Church of Christ in Japan, The United Church of Canada, and The Presbyterian Church (USA), he served as a missionary from Japan to the Japanese speaking people in Vancouver, Lethbridge, Toronto, and Philadelphia. He was also a former chancellor of the Fukuoka Jo-Gakuin, Japan.

Rev. Jung Hee Park (November 21, 1964 – January 31, 2016)

Jung Hee died peacefully on Sunday, January 31st, 2016 at home at the age of 51, after living courageously with cancer for a year.

After finishing graduate studies in theology at Ewha Womans University in Seoul, Korea, she worked with labourers marginalized in the process of the industrialization of the country through Sandol (Living Stone) Presbyterian Church and Cultural Centre for eight years.

After immigrating to Canada and preparing for ministry through the Centre for Christian Studies, she was commissioned as a diaconal minister and settled into Fingal United Church in 2005. While working with that congregation, she began a program toward a Doctorate in Theology at the Toronto School of Theology in 2008.

Her research explored an alternative concept of diakonia as companion rather than that of servant. Her most recent ministry was with the congregation of Trinity United Church in Grand Valley.

She was the beloved partner of Hyuk Cho and loving mother of Saepom and Luke.

Rev. Daisy Rosalin Rickard (January 21, 1925 – September 25, 2015)

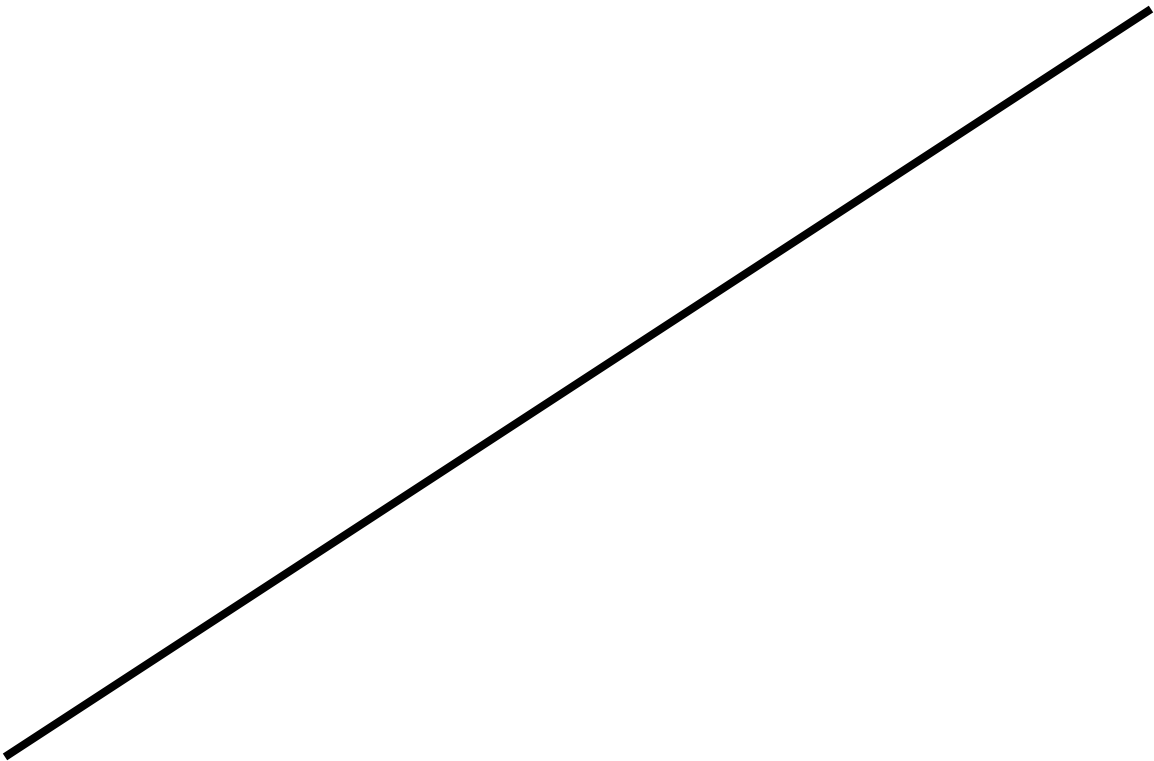
Daisy passed away peacefully on September 25, 2015, in her 91st year. She was a faithful member of the Bellefair and Beach United congregations.

Rev. Etta M. Snow passed away suddenly on Tuesday March 29, 2016 at her home in Etobicoke. Etta was born in Bay Roberts, Newfoundland; she was predeceased by her parents Philip and May; sister Helen; brothers Mark, Warren, Edward, Raymond, Sutherland and Philip Jr.; close friends, Lillian Taylor and Kay Pearson. Etta will be forever loved by her nieces, nephews and great nieces and great nephews.

Left with cherished memories are her numerous friends including Rev. Dr. Marion Pardy, Rev. Joyce Myers-Brown and the Umbundu people of Angola who called her “Ondembelek” – the Comforter. After serving there as a United Church missionary for 23 years, Etta returned to Canada and was the first United Church female from Newfoundland to be ordained. She then served pastoral charges in Ontario retiring after 60 years of faithful ministry. At the time of her death she was a Voluntary Associate Minister and Pastor Emerita of Humbervale United Church in Etobicoke.

Narrative budget: 2017-2019

The Conference Executive is guided by the Conference's mission statement: The mission of Toronto Conference is to strengthen Congregations, Pastoral Charges, Outreach Ministries, and Missions to be faithful followers of Jesus Christ.

To fulfill that mission, the Conference Executive will:

1. Make the best use of the human and financial resources available.
2. Ensure oversight and compliance within the polity of The United Church of Canada
3. Provide resources in the Presbyteries to promote the work in the following areas – program, property, personnel and public witness, with further support from the staff in the central Conference office.

Some commentary on the budget based on the mission statement:

1. Strengthening... to be faithful followers of Jesus Christ

Most of this work happens at the presbytery level of the church. Confirmation retreats, events for young people, workshops and presentations on social issues are a few examples of the initiatives that help to strengthen congregations to be faithful followers of Jesus Christ. Conference activities include training for Ministry & Personnel Committees, the work of the Settlement and Pastoral Relations Committee which attempts to match congregations and ministers to ensure effective ministry, consultations on mission support, and processing financial grant applications. A personnel emergency fund provides short-term assistance to ministers needing counseling.

2. Making the best use of human and financial resources

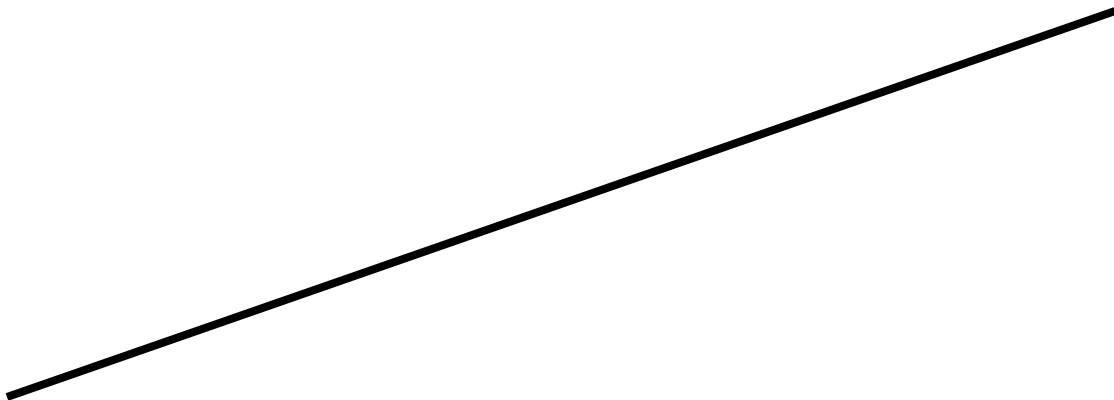
All costs of the presbytery offices are included in the budget. A common telephone system allows access to all staff using one telephone number, and staff have access to all computer files through a single computer network which is also tied in to the General Council computer system. All staff are supervised by the Executive Secretary. The Conference office is primarily an administrative and personnel centre while presbyteries look after program work. Generally, there is no overlap between the two courts in administrative and program work. The Conference's Finance and Property Administrator has oversight of all financial matters for the Conference and the four presbyteries, paying all bills based on presbytery-approved budgets; and she manages all of the offices, ensuring that the offices are well supplied, as well as looking after all necessary repairs.

3. Ensuring oversight and compliance

The Conference has numerous responsibilities which fall under the headings of oversight and compliance. Oversight includes responsibility for the religious life of the United Church. It has specific oversight of the four presbyteries. It looks after interviews for those in the various ministry processes; it ordains, commissions, and admits ministers. It oversees policies such as mandatory racial justice training and the sexual abuse policy of the United Church. Conference oversees the marriage licence registration system as required by the province, supervises 34 incorporated ministries, is a liaison with the General Council, elects and interacts with General Council commissioners, and plans an annual meeting with people present from every part of the Conference.

4. Providing resources to the Presbyteries

55% of this budget is spent in the presbyteries. The largest single item is staffing, but it also includes support for the governance and committee structures of the presbyteries. Congregations benefit from the universal membership in AVEL, the audio-visual library which is part of the Grand River Spiritual and Education Resources bookstore at Five Oaks. In addition, the archival services of the United Church are available.

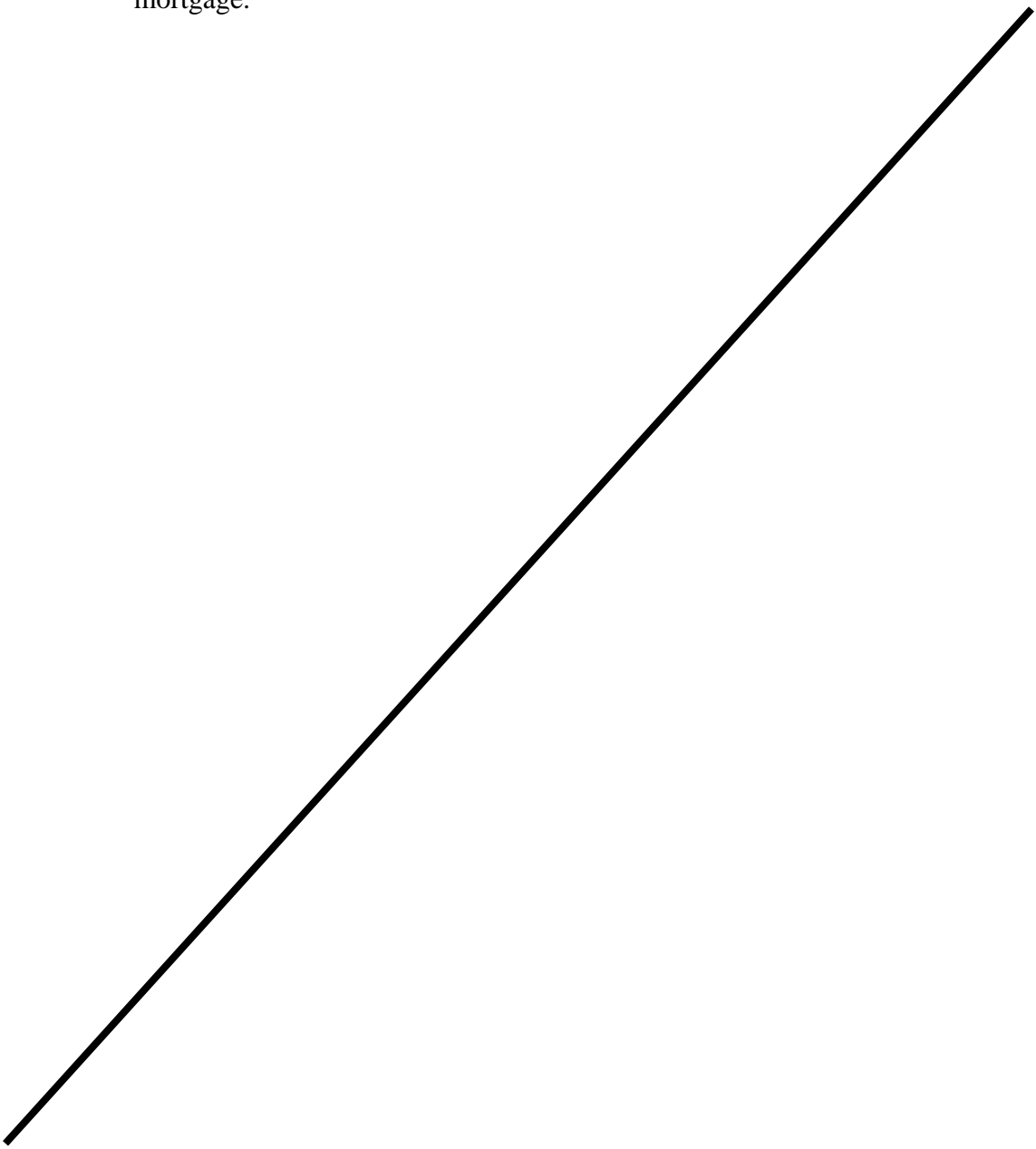

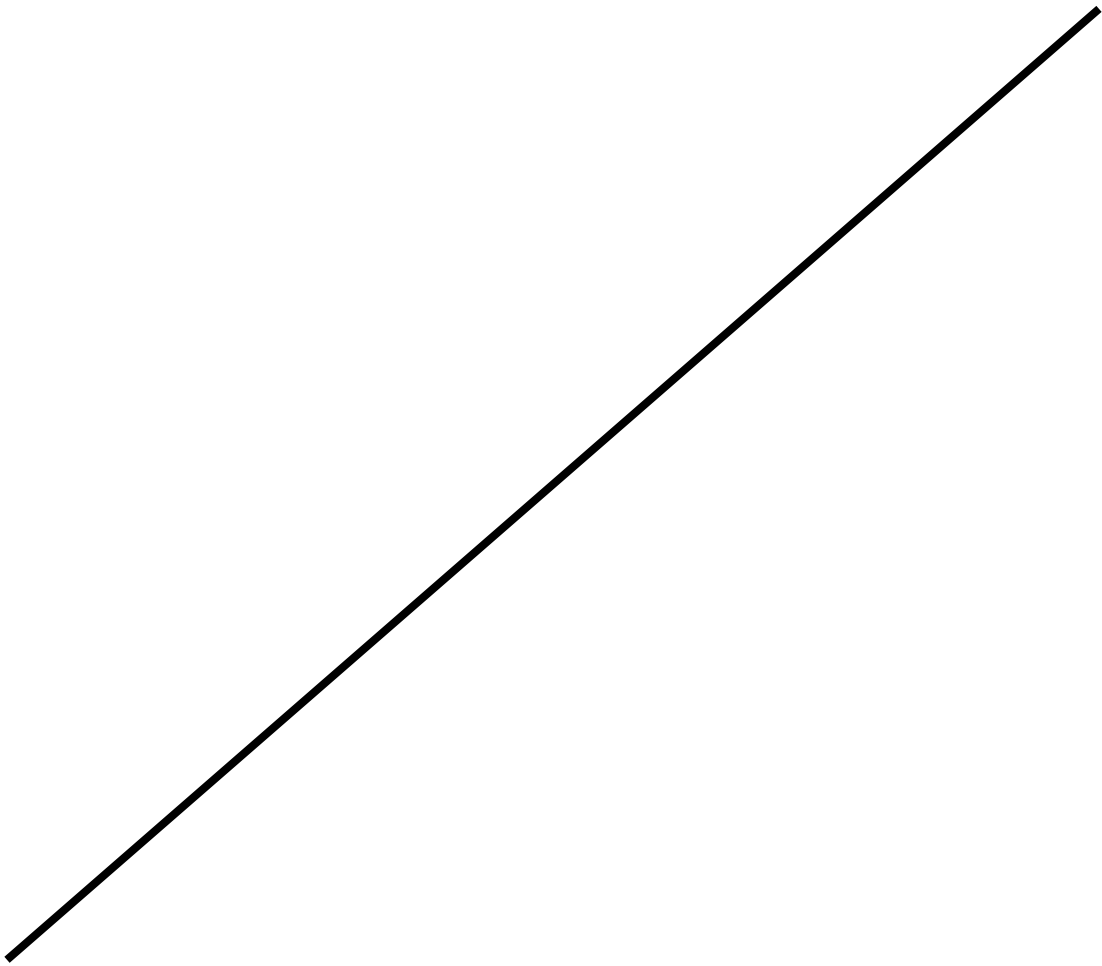

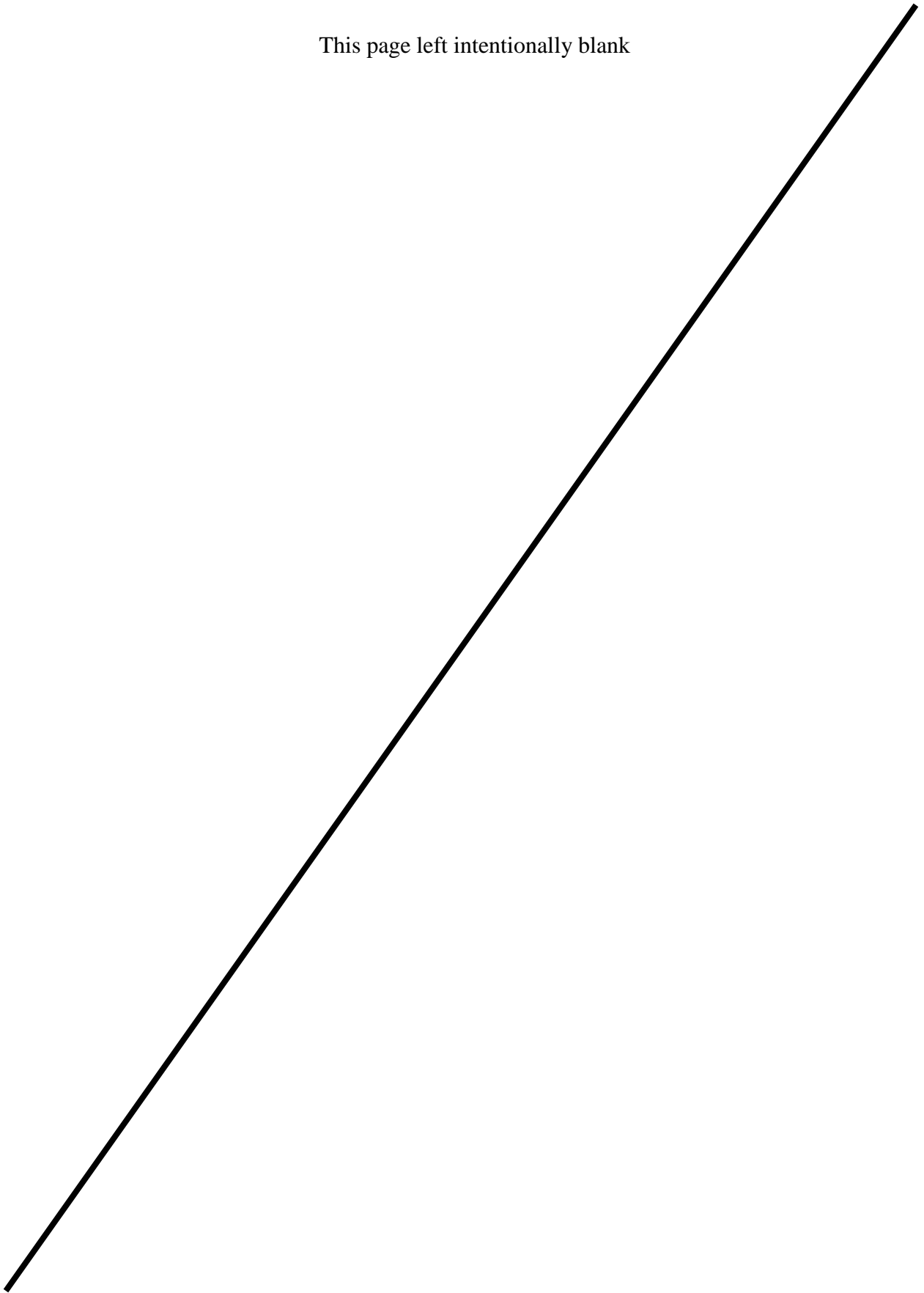
