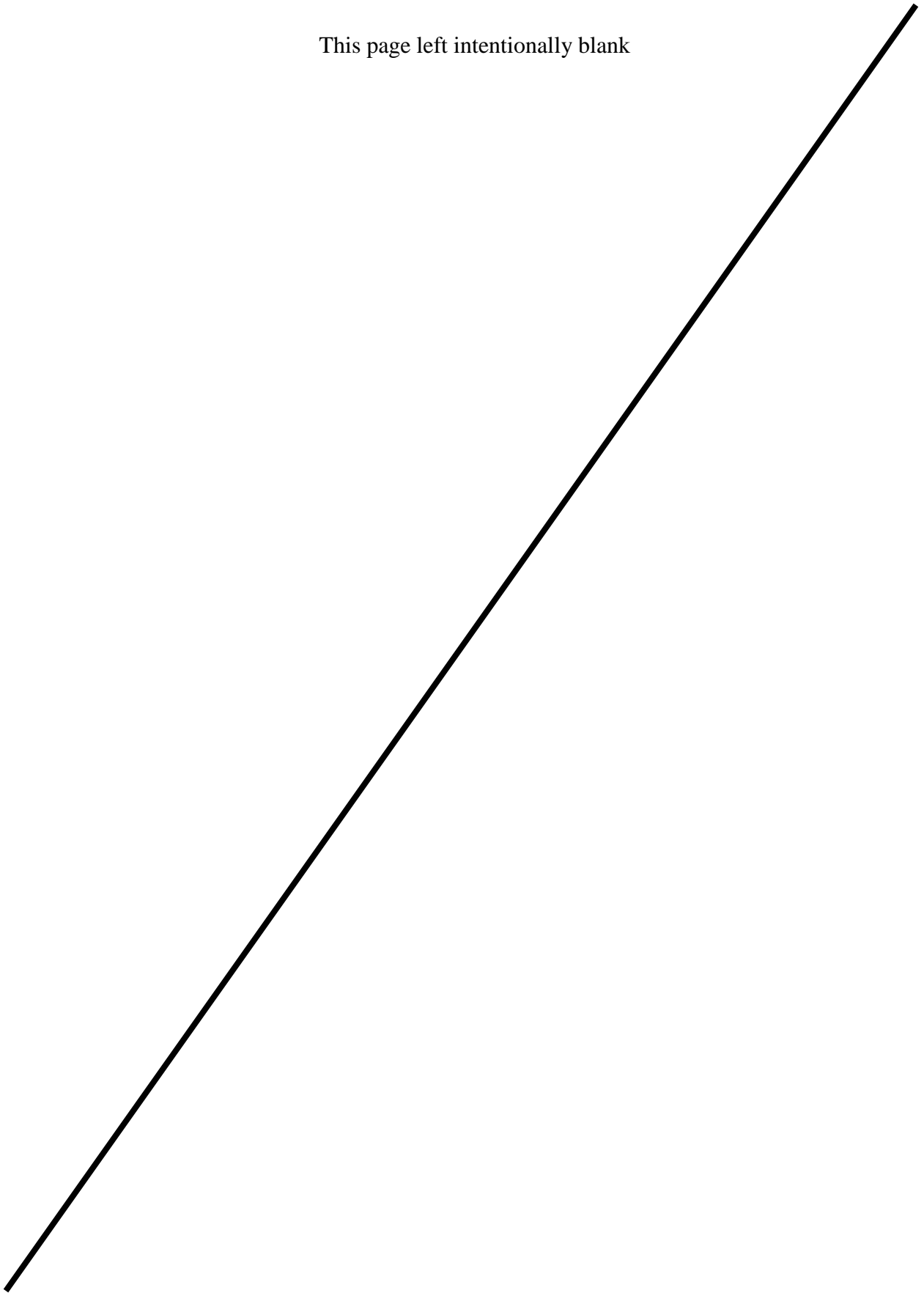

The 94th annual meeting of Toronto Conference took place on May 25-26, 2018 at the North Simcoe Sports & Recreation Centre and St. Paul's United Church, Midland. The theme was "Great is Thy Faithfulness" from Psalm 119:90.

**FRIDAY, May 25, 2018**

**MORNING SESSION**

Gathering music

Ruth McDonald and Todd McDonald led the court in gathering music.

Welcome, worship, honouring the land and constituting the Court

President Audrey Brown welcomed people to the 94th annual meeting of the Conference. The President led the meeting in worship assisted by Past-President Bryan Ransom. The court acknowledged that we are gathering on the traditional territories of Indigenous peoples. The President constituted the meeting in the name of Jesus Christ to conduct business properly brought before it. The President made a number of introductions.

Each staff member received a gift of a clay bowl created by Peter Michalski of Blind Alley Arts. Past-President Bryan Ransom offered the thanks of the Conference to President Audrey Brown and presented her with a gift of a campership for Camp Simpresca. The President spoke about the experiences she had as President and the significant role the church camp played in her life.

Proposal to General Council #1 – Funding and Support for LIRR Network Beyond 2018

Brian McIntosh made a presentation on this proposal and answered questions for clarification.

MOTION by Jody Maltby/Bryan Ransom that Toronto Conference agrees with the proposal titled “Funding Support for LIRR Network Beyond 2018”

and makes the following recommendation:

Recognizing that the General Council has no authority to bind current or future courts with responsibility for property sales, we recommend that congregations, presbyteries and proposed regions be invited, when property is being sold, to consider donating the land value to right relations and Indigenous justice work as an acknowledgement that our worship centres are on the traditional territories of Indigenous Peoples.

Proposal to General Council #2 – TRC Call 60/Blanket Exercise Proposal

Betty Lou McNabb and Ren Ito made a presentation on this proposal and answered questions for clarification.

MOTION by Jody Maltby/Bryan Ransom that Toronto Conference agrees with the proposal titled “TRC Call/60 Blanket Exercise”

and makes the following recommendations:

1. that this policy would not apply to Indigenous ministry personnel and lay leaders, understanding that it is the right and responsibility of the Indigenous ministries and communities of faith of The United Church to determine their own training needs;
2. that this policy be strongly encouraged for other than Indigenous lay leaders; and
3. that this training involve only the official Kairos Blanket Exercise or other tools that have been developed in collaboration with Indigenous ministries and communities.

### **SATURDAY, May 26, 2018**

#### **MORNING SESSION**

#### Gathering music

Ruth McDonald and Todd McDonald led the court in gathering music.

#### Morning worship

Past-President Bryan Ransom, and Chair of the Affirming Ministry Task Group, Anne Hepburn, led the opening worship.

#### Volunteer Appreciation

President Audrey Brown expressed the appreciation of Toronto Conference to the volunteers from St. Paul's United Church, Midland Ontario for all their work hosting the annual meeting for the past three years and presented a small gift of appreciation. The President also offered thanks to all those who have volunteered their time serving on a committee, consultation or circle of Toronto Conference, including those who serve in corporations and camps and the leadership of the youth and young adults at Conference. The court responded with applause.

#### General Council Representative

Erik Mathiesen, Chief Financial Officer, The United Church of Canada, brought greetings on behalf of the General Council and introduced a short video on Mission & Service.

#### Nominations Report

Past-President Bryan Ransom, chair of the Nominations Committee, brought a number of items to the meeting for consideration. He began by acknowledging the members of the Nominations Committee.

#### General Council Commissioners

The Executive Secretary Jody Maltby, outlined the process adopted by the Executive for electing the remaining six commissioners who will attend the General Council meeting in

2018. The court received one nomination from the floor, Nicholas Butler. The nominees for the remaining lay commissioner spoke to the court. They were Tracy Odell, who spoke via video conference, Jessica Stevenson, Sarah Jane Wetelainen and Nicholas Butler. Ballots were distributed. Bryan Ransom invited the court to write the name of one nominee on their ballot. The scrutineers gathered the ballots. While awaiting the results, the court continued its business.

#### Proposal to Toronto Conference #1: Extension of Terms of Office

On behalf of the Nominations Committee, Bryan Ransom introduced a motion to extend the terms of office for those currently serving in Conference volunteer positions with terms that end June 30, 2018.

Todd McDonald, staff person of the Conference's Settlement and Pastoral Relations Committee presented the committee's report on behalf of Chair, Andy Comar, and offered thanks to those who have helped with pastoral relations work in the last year.

#### Questions on accountability reports

Members of the court had an opportunity to submit questions about items in the various accountability reports. The court received one question regarding Incorporated Ministries. The Executive Secretary indicated that the information was not available currently but would be provided directly to the questioner and included in the minutes.

The question was: Could you break down the 30+ incorporated ministries regarding their particular area of ministry. e.g. Housing – Seniors (active) – Families - Nursing Homes -

seniors core services - camps – youth – delivering social services - health related - other?

Linda Gray, staff person to the Executive, has had conversation with and directed the questioner to the Toronto Conference Policies Handbook on the Toronto Conference website where all the incorporated ministries are listed and updated as the list changes and offered further assistance if required. Due to a number of corporations signing Legacy and Release Agreements, Toronto Conference now has oversight of 22 corporations. Four are United Church camps, one is a non-profit nursery school, and three are financial corporations. Six organizations support marginalized populations including two resource centres, one drop-in centre, one supporting pregnant and parenting adolescents and their babies, one social enterprise, and one offering a diversity of services and supports. Five organizations provide housing for seniors and one provides housing for seniors and families. Two are non-profit housing corporations.

and makes the following recommendations:

1. we acknowledge that the United Church is actively involved in South Korea and encourage our work with our partners to increase;
2. we join with global partners including the World Council of Churches in this work;
3. we acknowledge and advocate for the importance of peace talks through the council of churches in USA, North and South Korea;
4. we consider sending delegates instead of overseas personnel; and
5. any United Church of Canada overseas personnel or delegates going to North Korea do so at the request of North Korean churches.

5. that every region have a social justice animator to help in engaging this work.

Bri-Anne Swan made a presentation on this proposal and answered questions for clarification.

MOTION by Jody Maltby/Bryan Ransom that Toronto Conference agrees with the proposal entitled “*The Manual* item 5.3.3: Mandatory Meetings of the Pastoral Charge”

and makes the following recommendations:

1. that the General Council take into account the difference between smaller and larger churches in how they determine the required number; and
2. that the General Council consider using a required number and/or percentage, whichever is the greater.

The President recognized Robin Wardlaw on a point of personal privilege. Robin asked to make a motion that the Executive forward the remaining proposals regardless of their agreement or disagreement. The Executive Secretary advised that the court could not make such a motion to bind the Executive in its work. The President ruled the motion out of order but offered thanks for the wisdom offered.

### Affirming Ministry Task Group

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## OBITUARIES

### **The Reverend Gordon Hume (December 12, 1925 – August 11, 2017)**

Gordon Hume, a long serving, dedicated and respected leader and clergy with The United Church of Canada, passed away following a lengthy illness in Meaford on Friday August 11, 2017 at the age of 91.

Gordon is survived by his beloved wife, Reverend Helen Hume (nee Botell) of Meaford.

Gordon was the devoted grandfather and great-grandfather of Zachary Hume of Ohio; Bailey Hume of Meaford; Sean King and his wife Grace of New York and their children Karzi and Roberta; and Heather and her husband Sebastian Scala of Markham and their son Santino.

He was a dear brother to George and Anne Hume of Toronto and David and Jean Hume of Guelph. Gordon was predeceased by brothers Donald Hume of Collingwood and Sherwood Hume of Milton and will be recalled with kind affection by Sherwood's wife Gladys. Several nieces and nephews and their families will reflect fondly on the life their dear Uncle Gordon.

### **Audrey McKim (April 28, 1926 - September 26, 2017)**

Audrey Patricia Mary McKim grew up in the east end of Toronto. After graduating from the Eastern High School of Commerce on 1944, she worked briefly as a stenographer. She then attended the Ontario Ladies College in Whitby, Ontario, from which she graduated in 1949. She went on to complete a B.A. from Victoria College (1953) and a diploma from the United Church Training School (1954).

Audrey worked in diaconal ministry at Islington and Eglinton United Churches. She then worked with Wilbur Howard in the department of Christian Education at the national offices of the United Church. In 1962, she went with Crossroads Africa to Kenya where she helped to build a maternity ward. She fell in love with the country and its people, and returned to Kenya as overseas personnel with The United Church of Canada, working as secretary to John Kamau, the executive secretary of the Kenya Council of Churches. She later participated in writing and editing an inter-denominational (Catholic-Protestant) curriculum for use in Kenyan schools, and founded a secretarial school in South Sudan. Audrey was well loved and respected by her African colleagues. Her home was always open and welcoming to visitors.

Upon her return to Canada, Audrey worked at many jobs, which included mission secretary for Hamilton Conference, Personnel secretary for the Division of World Outreach, and Executive Secretary and Registrar at Emmanuel College. She was the administrator at St. Matthew's-Bracondale House, a residence for senior citizens, and then became the executive secretary to the Moderator of The United Church of Canada, Rev. Sang Chul



Lee. Audrey also used her secretarial and administrative skills in the corporate world when she worked for the Inglis Corporation.

Audrey lived life with zest and energy. She loved music and attended Tafelmusik concerts for many years. She continued her love of and interest in Africa until the end of her life. Her wide circle of friends loved her enthusiasm for life, her generosity and her wonderful laugh. She will be missed.

### **The Reverend Gordon Nodwell (March 25, 1928 – August 13, 2017)**

Gordon passed away at the Warkworth Place Nursing Home on Sunday, August 13th, 2017, in his 90th year. Loving son of the late Wallace and Etta Nodwell of Guelph. Beloved husband of Jessie (nee Borthistle) who was at his side for 64 years. Adored father of children, David (Ruth Harnden Nodwell), Tina (Bill Long), and Paul (Carrie Loring). Proud grandfather of Jonathan (Mellisa Geleynse) & Amy (Will Mitter), Ethan & James, and great-grandfather to Jordan and Adelynn. Dear brother of Ed Nodwell (the late Joan Nodwell), and sister, Joan Trathen (Bill Trathen). Gordon is also remembered by his many nieces, nephews, and close friends.

Gordon was ordained in 1956 and served at Victoria Harbour and Mount Dennis in Toronto Conference. Following that, Gordon was a professor at the Atlantic School of Theology for 12 years before serving as minister at Deer Park from 1976 to 1992. He was a theologian, writer, religious scholar and passionate speaker who touched the lives of many in the varied places that he worked throughout his remarkable career. His life was deeply rooted in ethics - gleaned from extensive reading and working with others. His gentle spirit, wisdom, generosity and faith served as an inspiration to all who came to know him. Whether in the church or the halls of academia, it can be fairly said that that he was one man who truly walked the walk. He was a student of the human condition and an advocate for the single most important product of life - Love.

### **The Reverend Wolfgang Roth (October 1, 1930 – November 25, 2013)**

Retired Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary Professor Wolfgang Roth died just after midnight on November 25, of congestive heart failure at his home in Evanston, Illinois. He was surrounded by his family in his last days. Wolfgang Max Wilhelm Roth was born on October 1, 1930, in Darmstadt, Germany, to Kaethe (nee Fiebig), who was a nurse and to Ludwig Wilhelm Roth, a civil servant.

Wolfgang completed his under-graduate studies at the University of Heidelberg. He earned his masters and doctorate in theology and Old Testament literature at Victoria University, Toronto, Ontario, in 1959. He married Janet Pearson in 1956, and together they moved to Madya Pradesh, India, where Wolfgang taught biblical studies and languages at the Leonard Theological Seminary. Dr. Roth began teaching at Garrett Theological Seminary in 1967 and continued there until his retirement in 1996. He served as the Academic Dean from 1982-1985. He was named the Frederick Carl Eiselen Professor of Old Testament Interpretation in 1981. In his later life, Wolfgang negotiated the difficult landscape of


Alzheimer's disease - first as he cared for Janet, his wife of 49 years, and later, with the help of his second wife Mary Beth, when he received his own diagnosis. His strength and determination to overcome every challenge was a source of inspiration to everyone.

Glenn will be missed by his sister Cheryl (Ian Shields), nephews David (Caroline), Michael (Stacey) and Scott, great nephews and nieces Blake, Mackenzie, Sawyer and Greyson, family in Peterborough, Kingston and Ottawa and many friends across Canada. Predeceased by his parents Don (2002) and Jean (2007) Smith and his aunts and uncles Bud and Joan Booth, Mary Booth of Peterborough, Gary Smith of Kingston and cousin Larry Booth of Brampton. 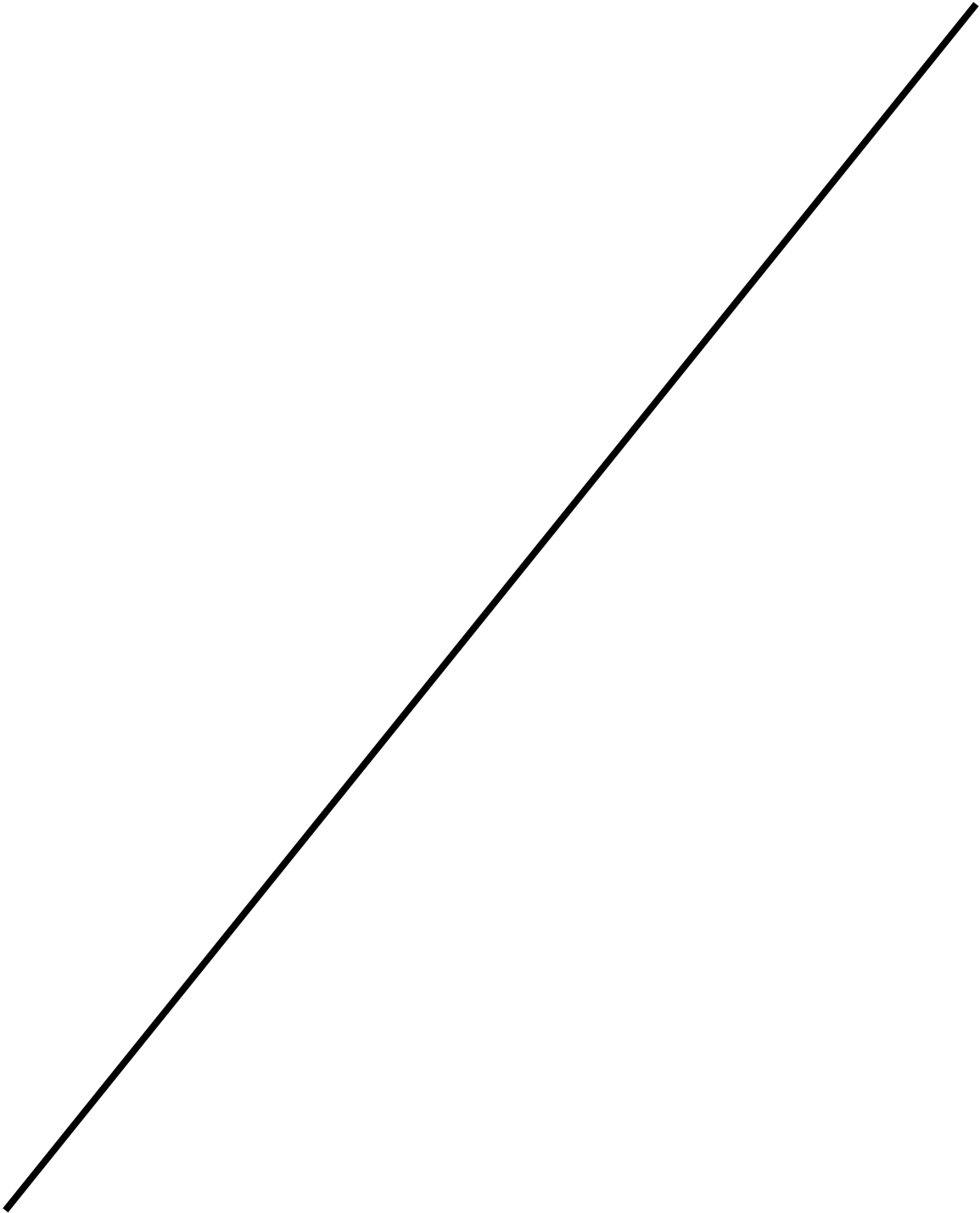

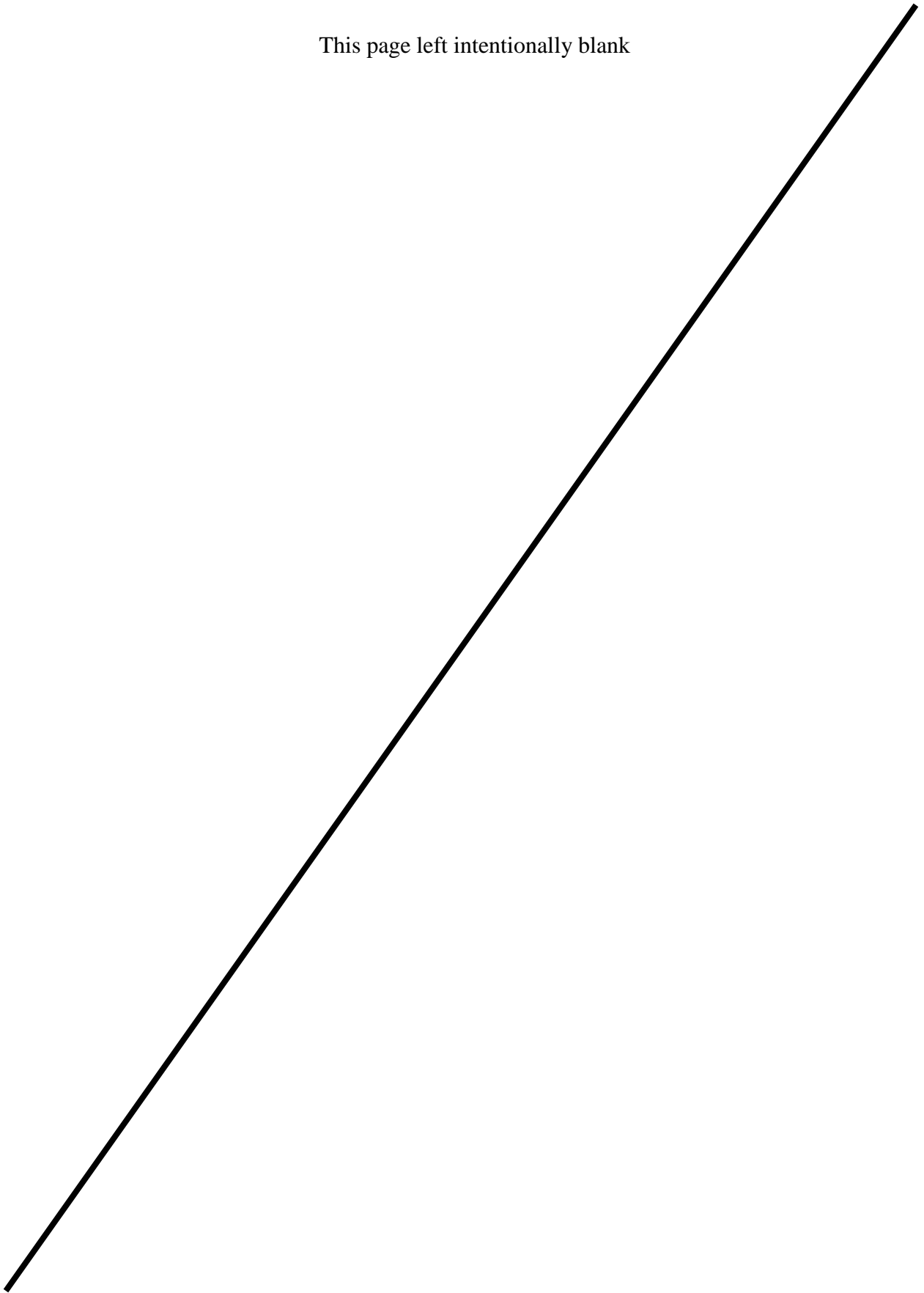
